



AGREEMENT FOR ACADEMIC COLLABORATION

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is entered into on this 4th day of January, 2025 (Effective Date) by and between :

AUNIATI UNIVERSITY

Kaliapani, Teok, Jorhat-785112, Assam, India
(Hereinafter referred to as "Party A" or "First Party")

And

MORIDHAL COLLEGE

Moridhal, Dhemaji-787057, Assam, India
(Hereinafter referred to as "Party B" or "Second Party")

WHEREAS, both Parties have agreed to collaborate in undertaking joint initiatives aimed at knowledge sharing for the betterment of faculty members and students.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and promises contained herein, the Parties agree as follows :

Article 1: Collaboration

1.1. The Parties shall assist each other in undertaking their respective academic developmental activities.

1.2. The Parties shall provide infrastructure facility and related support services to each other, whenever and wherever needed.

Article 2: Knowledge Sharing

2.1. The Parties shall regularly share relevant training and mentoring expertise.

2.2. The Parties shall provide training to teachers and students in respective and required areas.

Article 3: Joint Initiatives

3.1. The Parties may organize Faculty Exchange Programmes, Student Exchange Programmes, Internships, Fellowships, Scholarships, Seminars, Conferences, MOOCs (Massive Open Online Courses), joint ventures in publication projects, cultural exchange programmes, etc. under the joint banner of both Parties.

Article 4: Training and Development

4.1. The Parties may sponsor faculty/support staff to training programmes conducted by the other Party.

4.2. Such agreements shall be purely non-binding.

Article 5: Meetings and Reviews

5.1. The Parties shall organize regular meetings to identify areas of specific joint action/collaboration.

5.2. The Parties shall review the progress of ongoing activities of students and teachers.

Article 6: Financial Arrangements

6.1. The financial involvement (if any) of any activity shall be mutually decided.

6.2. Monetary involvement, if any, may be mutually agreed upon for hassle-free functioning of the scheme.

Article 7: Academic Resources

7.1. Party A may be introduced as an academic resource to governing bodies seeking information for the college's placement avenue.

Article 8: Term and Termination

8.1. This MoU shall take effect from the Effective Date and shall be valid for a period of three years from that date.

8.2. This MoU may be extended by mutual written agreement.

8.3. This MoU may be terminated by either Party after giving 30 days' notice of its intention to do so.

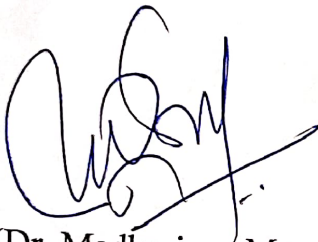
Article 9: Governing Law

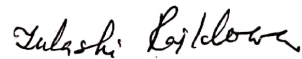
